The Dante card provides audio connectivity with any device capable of Dante networking and is capable of receiving up to 8 audio channels and transmitting up to 8 audio monitoring channels.

To install the Dante card into a PowerMatch amplifier, follow these instructions:

- 1. Turn off and unplug the PowerMatch amplifier.
- 2. Detach the rear expansion slot cover plate by removing the 2 screws. (See Figure 1.)
- 3. Align the Dante card with the plastic card guides in the open slot. Insert the card until the rear panel is flush with the amplifier. (See Figure 2.)







- 4. Screw the card into place.
- 5. Plug in the power cord and turn on the PowerMatch amplifier.
- 6. Using the front panel, navigate to the FIRMWARE VERSION screen (MAIN MENU<UTILITY<FIRMWARE VERSION).
- 7. Check the amplifier LCD screen to view whether the Dante card has been identified. (See Figure 3.)

8. If the card does not appear in the FIRMWARE VERSION screen, repeat steps 1-7. Be sure that the card is completely pushed into the slot, and that the card is properly aligned with the card guides.
